

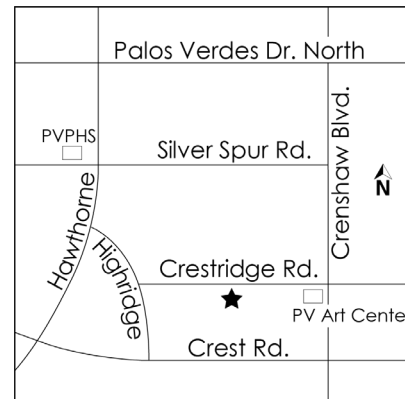

Sample Daily Schedule

- 12:30 Dismissal for 3½ hr. students

Programs Available

We offer two half-day programs:

3 hours: 9 am – 12:00 pm

5 hours: 9 am – 2:00 pm

In addition:

- optional early care (8:00-9:00 am) \$8/half hour.

Monthly Tuition

Our tuition is a yearly fee based on 180 school days. It is divided into 9½ monthly payments for your convenience. Initial payment includes first and last month (½ month) payment.
