Dear Parents~

Preschool Summer Camp Begins Monday, June 18th!!! Your child is registered to attend this week!

We are looking forward to seeing you on Monday, June 18th at **9 am**.

- **THEME:** The first week of Summer Camp will be *Spanish Fiesta*. Children will learn some basic Spanish words and a bit of culture, too! Should be a really great week!!
- **Arrival:** All students please come to the **RAINBOW** Room. All sign in sheets will be at that table.
- **NO DROP OFF FOR SUMMER:** Sorry... we just don't have enough staff....You are welcome to park there, **IF** you will pick up or drop off **QUICKLY!!** Remember others behind you are in a hurry, too!
- **Teacher/Student Ratios:** We have had a good enrollment for Summer Camp. We work hard to keep your children safe and supervised. So, we bring in teachers as enrollment grows to keep the student to teacher ratio low. We also will be breaking up the children in small groups the butterfly classroom for the morning throughout the summer..... so don't worry when you see a very full classroom! We will divide them up after the initial arrival.

Please remember to bring:

- **Lunch** - no NUTS please, this includes nutella, peanut butter, almond butter, etc.
- **Water bottle**
- **Closed toed shoes**
- **Change of clothes** in zip-lock bag
- **Diapers, pull-ups, wipes** if your child is still being potty-trained.
- **A towel or mat if your child naps** and is staying till 2 pm
- **Please label** your jackets, lunch box, clothes,etc. It really helps us!!!
- **WATER** play... it will be about once a week if weather permits (except VBS week)! If you want to leave a swim suit and towel here that would be GREAT! . Please let your child know that water day is **NOT** every day...
- **SNACK:** Children will be served a mid-morning snack. Usually a cracker and a fruit or vegetable. We ask for you to bring snack once in awhile to help us keep costs down. A snack calendar will be sent home this week for you to help us with snack as you do so graciously during the school year.
- **EMERGENCY FORM:** Only those listed on your emergency form are legally allowed to pick up your child. Please come by the office if you need to add other names.
- **JACKET:** We recommend that your child bring a jacket for cool mornings.
- **SCHOOL SAFE SHOES:** Make sure your child has safe, close-toed shoes to wear. Though it may be warm, they are still riding bikes, running etc. Close-toed shoes are the safest for school. If you would like, you may send water shoes for outside water play. Just be aware they may come home wet!

- Please apply sunscreen before they arrive.
- **PLAY CLOTHES:** Please send your child in play clothes that can get wet and dirty. Children learn when they are *ACTIVELY* engaged in play, art, sand and water, etc. Learning is a messy job!!! So, please dress your child in washable clothes that you don't mind getting dirty or painted!
- Make sure to put your child's name on **ALL** items!

I will try to keep you updated each week as to the theme and verse

The teachers rotate throughout the summer. You will see them all this summer. Ms. Ada is lead teacher this first week! We look forward to a great summer!!!
